

The Situation

One of the largest banks in Switzerland adopted the Application Lifecycle Management solution of one single major software provider. But during usage the project teams learned that this solution was not the right answer for their needs and caused many pains.

The bank decided to reorganize the process and opted for implementation of an integrated tool chain based on different best-of-breed tools of several vendors. For the requirements management discipline, they have been looking for a solution capable of integrating with their Change Management, Task Management, UML modeling and Test Management tools and able to answer to the demands of their requirements engineers. The new tool for requirements management had to:

- Support the conceptual separation of project and product lifecycles
- Allow the creation of common specifications to satisfy identical requests in different projects
- Improve collaboration between project team members
- Allow an overview of the overall developed product without having to check the history of every single project over the complete product lifecycle
- Keep specifications consistent with current product behavior
- Support the defined process and guarantee consistency over the whole project lifecycle
- Provide the ability to rollback to any point in the past to review and understand system status at that time

The Selection

Polarion participated in an extensive evaluation process including tool solutions from 15 different tool vendors.

This process consisted of a Request for Information (RFI), a showcase including 25 Use Cases, and a Request for Proposal (RFP) in which about 2,000 questions had to be answered. The tool evaluation involved a broad community of engineers throughout the bank.

After passing a Proof of Concept (PoC) focused on the tool integration to show data exchange and synchronization between the different tools, Polarion was chosen by the engineering community as the "best-of-bread" tool for Requirements Management to complement the tool chain.

In the following pilot phase, more than 300 users participated in the production roll-out of the Requirements Management solution. In the final stage of the implementation, about 1,500 users are planned to work with Polarion REQUIREMENTS.

The Solution and its Benefits

Integration: The open and modern architecture of Polarion REQUIREMENTS is best integrated with the bank IT infrastructure and gives the chance to connect to other tools used by the client through APIs and a common integration framework. In the bank's tool-chain it perfectly integrates requirements management with UML-models managed in Sparx Enterprise Architect, and the selected

change management and test management solutions. Subversion was selected as Version Control System for further documentation and source code.

Flexibility: The Polarion REQUIREMENTS tool is flexible in order to support different project lifecycle processes such as Waterfall, RUP or Agile.
